At Long Lake we have only 250 campers and 160 staff. That means your camper will be safe and well-supervised (but not stifled), get superior attention, and get what they want. Why We Have Campers Only up to 16

It is important to know that we do not allow 17- and 18- year olds to attend Long Lake as campers or as CIT's or counselors as other camps do. They are too old to be campers and too young to supervise and guide. Their focus at this age is on adult issues. Some children at this age have a social agenda that is inappropriate for any camp. Your trust in us makes 17- and 18-year old campers, CIT's, or counselors beyond consideration. *Why would you want your precious son or daughter to be influenced by 17- and 18-year olds while away from home?*

Loyal Staff Ensures Consistently High Quality

Our department heads have been with us for 15-20 years or more. This means that trusted, experienced, mature adults oversee every detail in every department. This makes Long Lake stable, secure and consistently high-quality for you and our campers as they grow and flourish throughout their years at Long Lake.

Our staff are more mature than other camps and are chosen for their unique capabilities, their ability to lead and reach young people and be positive role models. The Music and Art staff are around 25 years old. The Drama and Dance staff are 30- 40 years old or more. The Sports and Circus staff tend to be around 23 – 26. The staff in the bunks at night are also teachers by day and are 21-26.

Long Lake screens all staff thoroughly and only selects talented individuals who are exciting, organized and mature enough to create a safe and fun environment. Please remember to ask any camp you consider to tell you the ages of the staff working with your camper.

Inspiring and Impressive Surroundings

The campus is paradise and even campers who have not learned to see or appreciate the world around them stop and enjoy the inspiring beauty that is Long Lake.
