For your camper's safety, please know that we will not allow them on camp without their medical forms properly signed by parents and doctors and sent into the office. All our forms are available on our website (longlakecamp.com) - click on Parents and then Forms and Documents.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE All details about dates/times are arranged by session on the "Travel Questionnaire." Be sure to look up the details there before making your travel plans. If you wish to use our chartered bus up to camp, keep in mind that: *THERE ARE NO CHARTERED BUSES RETURNING HOME. THE FINAL DAYS OF CAMP ARE VISITORS' WEEKENDS FILLED WITH ACCOMPLISHMENTS, WHICH YOU SHOULD DEFINITELY ATTEND. We know that for some of our campers who fly to us that this is not possible – don't worry – we'll make your camper feel special!*

VISITORS' WEEKEND DATES AND TIMES FOR PARENTS TO BE AT CAMP

All times are exact and the owners will welcome parents at 10 am before the first show.

1st Three-Week Session

Begins on Saturday, July 14 at 9:30 am and ends on Sunday, July 15 at 3:00 pm More details will be sent in our July letter.

2^{nd} Three-Week Session and 1^{st} Six-Week Session

Begins on Saturday, August 4 at 9:30 am and ends on Sunday, August 5 at 3:00 pm. More details will be sent in our July letter.

3rd Three-Week Session and the 2nd Six-Week Session

Begins on Friday, August 24 at 2:30 pm and ends on Sunday, August 26 at 9:00 am. More details will be sent in our August letter.

Please see "Hotels" list for some suggestions of where to stay. For the First and Second Session, families should arrive in the area Friday night. Please note there is no visiting for 1st and 2nd Visitors' Weekends on Friday; for 3rd Visitors' Weekend, there is no visiting on Thursday. Thank you.

<u>CAMPERS WHO ARE FLYING HOME</u> If Long Lake is taking your camper to the airport for departure home, the actual air travel date should be the day after camp ends for the 1st or 2nd session. For the First Session, the fly home date is July 16 and for the Second Session it is August 6. For the Third Session the actual air travel date is the final day of camp, August 26. PLEASE CALL US TO GO OVER FLIGHT DETAILS ASAP <u>BEFORE</u> YOU FINALIZE THE FLIGHT. Thank you. We only pick up and drop off at Albany airport. See all travel details in the "Travel Questionnaire."

LUGGAGE You can bring <u>one</u> duffel bag or suitcase to the buses. Musical instruments, tennis racquet, sleeping bag, etc. can be carried onto the bus. <u>NO TRUNKS CAN BE TAKEN.</u> We recommend for your comfort and convenience having UPS pick up your camper's duffel bag at your door. Average cost is \$60 and cross-country delivery takes only 3-5 days. Please visit: UPS.com or call 1-800-PICK-UPS. <u>RENTAL CARS</u> Please do not rent a ZIP car as there is no cell phone reception at camp which you need to open your car doors!

<u>CLOTHING AND FOOD</u> A suggested "Packing List" is online. Long Lake Camp is not a dress-up camp; functional clothing is practical and desirable. You can mark clothing with initials using an indelible laundry marker if desired - much easier than name tags. We also have an "Apparel Order" form if you wish to order any apparel with our logo – this is optional. *Please do not mail any food or drink to camp, we will not give food to your children we have not prepared ourselves.*

<u>MEDICAL</u> All medical forms must be filled out accurately and completely. <u>The N.Y.S. Health</u> <u>Department requires immunizations and the dates to be noted</u>. This, of course, is for your child's protection. If your child is undergoing any special medical or therapeutic treatment it is essential that we are notified. Please note all the details on the "Parent Questionnaire." Long Lake Camp must also have a copy of the front and back of every camper's medical insurance card. Camp Meds is mandatory for all campers from the U.S. who are taking daily prescription medications.

OPTIONAL LINEN SERVICE For your convenience we do have a linen service which will supply all the necessary linen items mentioned on the clothing list. Campers still need to bring a lightweight sleeping bag for overnight camping, a beach towel, and washcloths/face cloths if desired. The service fee will be \$60 for an entire 3- or 6-week stay. You can choose this option on the final invoice which we will send before March. This includes sheets, blankets, pillow cases, (pillows included with camp) and bath towels. This is separate from laundry - we do laundry for campers individually at no additional cost.

HORSES Long Lake has an excellent English riding program. We own the horses and they are on camp property. Instruction includes walking, trotting, cantering, jumping, posting and trail rides. This is the only activity for which there is an additional charge. You can select this on final invoice which we will send before March. **WE SUPPLY HELMETS. Campers must have over-the-ankle boots with a** cutaway heel (so that the boot sits securely in the stirrup).

CELL PHONES Cell phones are not allowed to be used for calling or internet services while on camp. If your camper is flying, it is a good idea to pack the phone so they can call you when they arrive. We ask all campers to keep their phones on airplane mode during camp and to use them for music and pictures only. Cell phones can be easily damaged and lost and they cost \$500 to replace. We will not replace lost or damaged phones.

<u>PARENT & CAMPER QUESTIONNAIRE</u> Please take the time now to fill out both questionnaires and return to us. The information will greatly help us to fulfill both your wishes and goals for the summer program as well as your child's.

YEARBOOKS & SHOW VIDEOS For campers in the first two sessions, a yearbook will be mailed to the home address on file. For campers in third session, they will be given a yearbook before they leave camp. Show videos will be available to purchase in September when we email the video order forms.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE -- INVOICES ARE EMAILED MONTHLY

On the 1st of each month after enrolling, please send us \$500; the balance is due in full by March 1st 2018 please. All fees must be paid in full before March 1st. Thank you.

Long Lake Camp Travel Requirements

Please note the **only** ways to transport your child to and from Long Lake are the following:

- 1. Drive your child to camp yourself. You can pick them up at the end or we can take them to Albany airport to fly home.
- 2. Meet us at one of the chartered bus pick-up locations and we will take your child to camp. You can pick them up at the end or we can take them to Albany airport to fly home.
- 3. Have your child fly to Albany airport where we will meet them. You can pick them up at the end or we can take them back to Albany airport to fly home.
- 4. You can fly a private plane to Saranac Regional Airport then arrange for a private car service to be waiting for you. You can pick them up at the end or we can take them back to Albany airport to fly home.
- 5. Take a seaplane to land on Long Lake and dock at our beach. You can pick them up at the end or we can take them back to Albany airport to fly home.
- 6. Take a helicopter to land on our sports fields; please call us to get the coordinates so we can arrange a safe landing. You can pick them up at the end or we can take them back to Albany airport to fly home.

Very Important

- Albany is the only airport we can pick-up and drop-off at.
- We DO NOT pick up or drop off ANY campers from JFK, La Guardia, Newark, Montreal, Boston, etc.
- You must please call or email us with your itinerary BEFORE paying for your trip; we need to know the inbound and outbound days and times. We will make sure the dates and times are prefect so you can confirm yor arrangements.
- If you make travel plans that fall outside of the requirements above we may cancel your enrollment with no refund.

Please note that we are always as accommodating as possible and we appreciate that families travel from very far away, but we must have very good communication from you about your travel plans to ensure a safe and speedy trip for your child. We appreciate your help in making travel go smoothly for your camper so they start and end camp on a great note.

TAKING OUR CHARTERED BUS TO CAMP

Please be courteous and respectful to Long Lake Staff; they are doing an extremely difficult job ensuring the safety of your children and need your full cooperation and support. Please-<u>Please</u> DO NOT BE IN A HURRY. Plan to arrive 30 minutes before the bus is scheduled to leave. It will take time to load the luggage and check attendance- please help to make the beginning of camp enjoyable for yourself, your child and others. Your patience is expected and required. THERE MAY BE MANY CAMPS AT THE PICK-UP LOCATIONS. MAKE SURE THE BUS YOU ARE PUTTING YOUR CAMPER ON IS GOING TO LONG LAKE CAMP. OUR STAFF HAS LONG LAKE CAMP T-SHIRTS.

For your safety:

- STAY ON SIDEWALKS, OFF THE STREET AND OUT OF PASSING TRAFFIC.
- WHEN BUSES ARRIVE, DO NOT APPROACH BUSES UNTIL THEY COME TO A FULL STOP AND A LONG LAKE STAFF MEMBER GIVES INSTRUCTIONS- BUSES MAY HAVE TO MOVE SEVERAL TIMES UNTIL PARKED CORRECTLY. Please wait for instructions.
- CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT UNTIL BOARDING OF BUSES.
- MAKE SURE THE BUS IS FOR LONG LAKE CAMP- OUR BUSES WILL SAY "VANDERHOOF TRANSIT" ON THE SIDE AND HAVE "LONG LAKE" T-SHIRTED STAFF.

For your comfort and convenience:

- Be sure your camper has a disposable lunch for the trip no cans or bottles please.
- If anything changes and you won't be using the bus pick-up location you chose on the Travel Questionnaire, please call us at 914-693-7111 and let us know right away.
- Limit the items your camper brings on the bus. We recommend for your comfort and convenience having UPS pick up your camper's duffel bag at your door. Average cost is \$50 and cross-country delivery takes only 3-5 days. Please visit: www.UPS.com or call 1-800-PICK-UPS (1-800-742-5877). Driving Directions to Long Lake Camp From Albany, NY

Exact location for GPS: 83 Long Lake Camp Way, Long Lake, NY 12847

NOTE: Please be sure to use Exit 23 for Warrensburg. GPS directions suggest Exit 24, but your trip will be easier and there are more options for gas, food, etc.


From the NEW YORK STATE NORTHWAY (Route 87) NORTHBOUND, take Exit 23:

- Turn left at stop sign, then right at stoplight onto Route 9 (at the McDonald's)
- Outside of Warrensburg, turn left onto Route 28 at flashing light
- Follow RT 28 through Weavertown, North River, Indian Lake. You'll go about 40 miles.

RT 28 circles around; always stay straight at any intersection for RT 28. Do not make any hard left or right turns onto anything marked 28N (28N will go to Long Lake too but it takes longer) At Indian Lake, 28 joins with RT 30- follow Routes 28 and 30 to Blue Mountain Lake, 11 miles.

- At Blue Mountain Lake, turn right at stop sign (stay on RT 30) at gas station (sign says Long Lake 11 miles).
- In Long Lake, turn left at the store "Hoss's Country Corner" and follow that road through town over large bridge.
- Turn right on 2nd road after bridge onto "Kickerville Road"
- Follow Kickerville road for about 2 miles, look for our sign on the right-hand side, "Long Lake Camp For The Arts." There is a big stone gate on the right.

On Visitors' Weekend, please park on the sports field. Any other time, please drive very slowly down the tree-lined road to the teardrop lawn. The office has a latticed entryway.



Flying TO and FROM Camp

Before you book and pay for your flights, we urge you to please be sure to review the arrival and departure options below and call us to confirm the date and times. Please avoid any connections through Newark, NJ – they have the most flight delays/cancelled flights of any airport.

There is a \$70 charge for Albany airport pick-up. If you need us to also take your camper back to Albany for their flight home (if you can't join us for Visitors' Weekend), there is no additional charge.

DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL CAMPERS FLY INTO ALBANY, NEW YORK

This is the closest airport to camp (only 2 hours south) and the airport code is ALB

As airlines practice tighter security – especially on international flights – passports with names that do not match exactly (letter-for-letter) can be refused at check-in time. This results in being refused boarding. All campers with foreign passports should have valid U.S. Visas. Countries with recent treaties with the U.S. that do not require such Visas place severe limitations on entering the U.S. that may not be able to be met without a Visa. We highly recommend obtaining a valid U.S. Visa.

Options Available for Camp 2018

Tuition for camp includes all the activities, individual lessons, supplies, food, and lodging your camper needs. There are a few options you can choose if you wish.

How to let us know which options you wish

On the final invoice we will email you before March, please check off any options you wish and include the amount in your final payment. Options must be selected by March 1, 2018. If you need to make changes after that, please call us. If you wish rent an instrument after March 1st, please know that we need to know at least two weeks before your child arrives at camp.

Linens \$60: Includes pillow case, sheets, blankets, and bath towels. We do laundry each week (that's included in tuition) and make sure our campers are comfortable. If you do choose linen rental, please also be sure to pack a sleeping bag and washcloths/face cloths if desired.

Buses To Camp \$70: We charter modern, comfortable coaches with professional and trusted drivers. Our own staff accompany the campers. We do not have any buses back home due to our Visitor's Weekend.

Airport Pick Up and Drop Off \$70: We can meet your camper at Albany airport and take them back there to fly home. The cost is \$70 total for either one way or both.

Instrument Rentals \$60 to \$100: You are welcome to bring your own instruments with you, but if you prefer you can rent one though us. We have drums and pianos already at camp so there is no need to rent those. We can rent you guitars (electric, acoustic), electric basses, woodwind and brass instruments. Other instruments may also be rented – please call us with your specific needs. The cost depends on the instrument and covers a 3-week or a 6week stay.

Shy Campers - Long Lake offers our campers a tremendous number of opportunities, which can be overwhelming. If your child is shy, please encourage them to speak up and tell us if there is anything we can do to help. Our Unit Leaders excel at helping campers if they tell us what they need or if there are any problems.
