



QUICK LINK: Suggested Packing List, Luggage, Linen and Laundry

This list is only a recommendation and it is not necessary to purchase all these items new. We suggest you label clothing and belongings; it's not mandatory and you're welcome to use whatever method/labeling product you prefer. We also suggest shipping as much as possible in advance if you're choosing the Bus option to get to camp. *Please remember not to send anything irreplaceable to camp. PLEASE SEE THE NEXT PAGE ABOUT THE BEST LUGGAGE TO USE.*

Clothing

4-6 short-sleeve shirts
5 pr. Shorts
2 long-sleeve t-shirts
4 pr. jeans/long pants (and belts if desired)
2 sweatshirts
10 pr. Socks
12 pr. Underpants
2 pr. Pajamas
2-4 bathing suits
Bathrobe
Heavy jacket (like a fleece jacket)
3 white tee shirts
Dressy outfit (Night Club activity *3rd session only*)
Raincoat/hat or poncho

Linens

2 sheets, 54" x 90" (twin flat)*
2 heavy blankets*
3 bath towels*
Pillowcase* (pillow is provided)
Face cloths/washcloths (if desired)
Beach towel
Lightweight sleeping bag for overnight camping

Hip hop shoes (if you like hip hop)
Black jazz pants, jazz sneakers/shoes

Please use soft luggage only; duffel bags are ideal. Soft luggage with wheels also works. Do not use hard-sided suitcases. **NO TRUNKS CAN BE USED.** Campers will unpack into cubbies/drawers/hanging space.

if you choose to have your camper take our BUS or FLY to Camp, please ship as much luggage as possible in advance. The more luggage you ship, the smoother your camper's departure and arrival will be. We'll have their luggage waiting for them at their bunk.

How and When to Ship Luggage

Please send via UPS **ONLY** if you choose to have your camper take our BUS or FLY to Camp. UPS (United Parcel Service) is the service we suggest; they offer pick up from your house: 1-800-PICK-UPS. We do not accept trunks. Even if you are dropping off your camper, please do not pack in a trunk.

IF YOU ARE DROPPING OFF YOUR CAMPER, YOU DO NOT NEED TO SHIP LUGGAGE IN ADVANCE.

Dates to arrange luggage to arrive at Camp:

- Session start date June 26: **between Tuesday, June 20th and Thursday, June 22nd**
- Session start date July 18: **between Tuesday, July 11th and Thursday, July 13th**
- Session start date August 8: **between Tuesday, August 1st and Thursday, August 3rd**

What To Pack If You Choose to Rent Linens (a \$60 Option)

It includes: Pillowcase (a pillow is provided for free), Sheets, Blankets, Bath towels

You'll still need to pack:

- Sleeping bag
- Beach towel
- Washcloths/face cloths (if desired)

Laundry – included in tuition

We do campers' laundry for them once a week individually – this is included in the tuition. Please do not over pack. They give us their laundry bag (labeled with an indelible laundry marker) in the morning and they get it back that evening. The bunk counselors remind them to put their towels and bedding in the bag too. We wash each camper's bag of laundry as one single load and dry it as a single load. Please keep this in mind when deciding what to pack (a new pair of black shorts might run and discolor other items in that load.) There is no need to pack any laundry supplies aside from a laundry bag with your camper's name clearly marked on the outside of it. We suggest a nylon bag (not mesh). If you choose to rent linens instead of bringing them, this does not affect doing their laundry – we wash everything that goes into the laundry bag regardless of whether the linens are yours or rentals.
